

Safe Harbor Exit Criteria

Time Line: Minimum 45 days to reach academic and behavioral goals individualized to the student (ILPA)

Expedited 30 day timeline for students who do not meet minimum reading level requirements, who need credit recovery, or academically fast track to MS/HS

Guiding Questions: Can I meet the typical expectations of the typical classroom?

Individual Learning Plan Addendum:

Students will meet their individual (academic and employability) goals 85% of the time as established by the ILPA (Individual Learning Plan Addendum, or Individual Plan of Instruction, or Individual Evaluation Plan) student support team. Safe Harbor will utilize employability goals as criteria to transition students to the Blended Classroom and the Live Direct Instruction classrooms. Students will be recommended to the District Placement Committee once they have achieved their goals. Student goals are created by their ILPA support team and the measures identified in the ILPA will be utilized (academic/employability).

The exit criteria process is the general process/criteria for the average student. Administrator discretion for individual student circumstance will be final decision.
