With a goal of increasing access to recovery services and reducing stigma and overdose deaths, **Voices Of Hope** will be hosting events like naloxone training & distribution days via the **Meet Hope** project and Lexington's annual **Overdose Awareness Day** held each year in August.

Voices Of Hope is extremely proud to announce **Get Help Lex** – a free, interactive, online addiction recovery resource locator that will serve as a user-friendly guide to connect people in crisis with those who can help.
